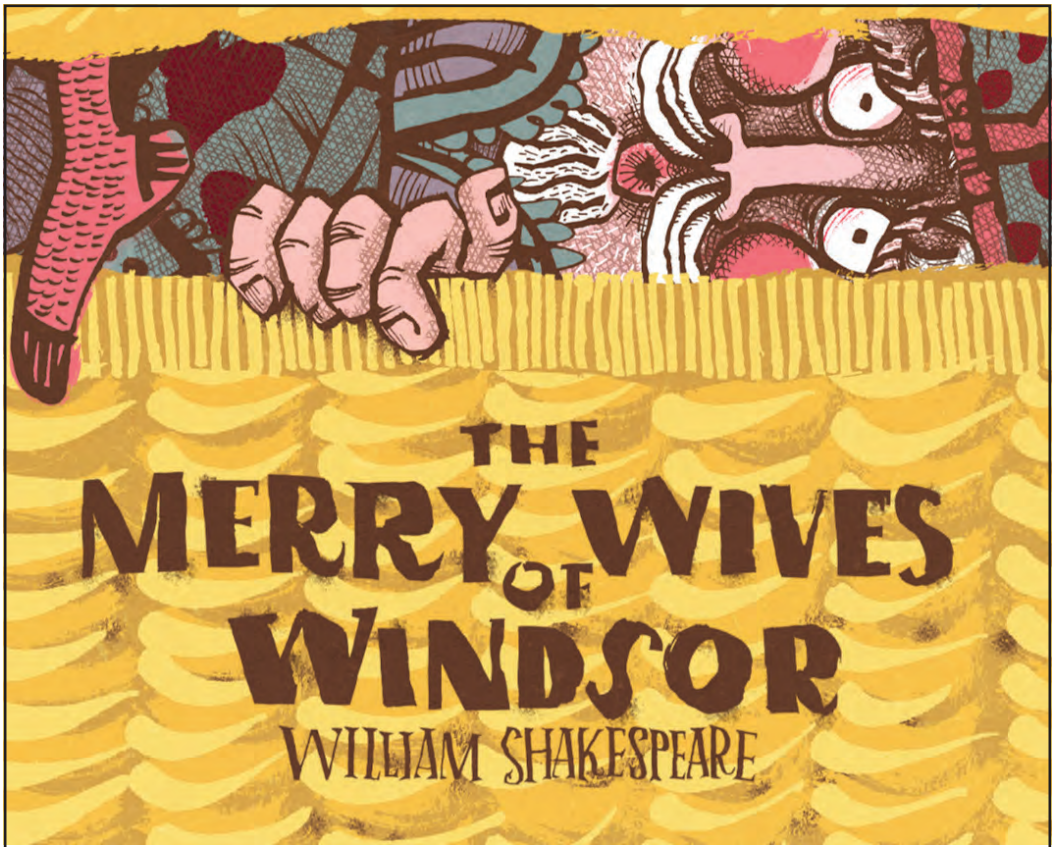

Chapmanslade Parish Council

Parish Council Briefing

Councillor Tim Humphreys reports on the PC's March meeting

The Parish Council (PC) met at the Village Hall on 13th March with two members of the public present.

Councillor Phil Holihead chaired the meeting. There were no conflicts of interest raised.

Public comments

Frustration was expressed with the continued delay in delivery of new “self-closing pedestrian gates” from Wiltshire Council. Councillor Holihead advised a positive response had been received from the Rights of Way officer to his correspondence with the head of local highways, but he will contact again to try and expedite.

Concern was raised over the planning application “Certificate of Lawfulness” for the sought farm shop at Adams Hill Farm on Lodge Hill.

Planning applications

Discussed in closed session by the councillors were:

PL/2025/01460 *64 High Street - Material alterations to front façade including alterations to existing fenestration, finishing materials, side extension roof structure and loft conversion.*

The Council supported this application.

(Somerset) 2025/0180/CLP *Adams Hill Farm, Lodge Hill – Certificate of Lawfulness of proposed development for the change of use from agricultural barn to farm shop – Class R permitted use.*

It was agreed to object to this application primarily of grounds that the application is simply not sustainable and in breach of

the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 and as such does not meet the lawfulness requirements for the proposed development. The given shop area appears conveniently just within Class R criteria but with very questionable allowance for practical on-site visitor and commercial parking which appears to breach the curtilage conditions of the legislation on size. The PC had previously objected to the earlier application for a far more extensive farm shop and café complex on this site, including substantial dedicated parking (2023/0518/FUL) and the application had been refused by Somerset Council.

Planning Appeal (Somerset) 2021/1675/EOUT *Sellwood Garden Village - Land to the South of Frome, west of Blatchbridge Road and East of A361. Application for outline planning permission for erection of up to 1700 homes, care homes, employment land, primary school, cafes/restaurants and convenience store.*

In essence, the Secretary of State has taken over this application, with an enquiry scheduled to start on 29th July. Public comments are invited against a closing date of 4th April.

The Council previously objected to this development primarily due to concerns over the wider, and inevitable, implications on our community of increased traffic along the A3098. There appears to be little, if any, consideration beyond the Somerset boundary. In addition, there is no given plan

for sustainable travel beyond the limits of the proposed development, only within Frome town itself.

Matters arising

A3098 Travel Weight Limit

Councillor Holihead will re-contact the Local Highway and Footway Improvement Group for progress having recently issued the necessary formal proposal to change the current 18T limit to 7.5T.

CIL funding

No further potential projects have been raised by parishioners and there remains almost £11,000 of unallocated funds available. The PC would welcome receipt of funding requests for consideration.

Local Council elections

Parishioners should now have received their election cards. Application process is given on the PC website under tab www.chapmansladepc.org.uk/parish-council/pc-elections/

Next PC meeting

The annual Parish Meeting is scheduled at 7 pm at the village hall on Thursday 10th April, followed by the next PC meeting at 7.45pm.

Hope in Springtime – An Easter message from Bishop Karen

‘Hope is the bird that waits for dawn and sings while it is still dark.’ This is one of my favourite quotations, which particularly comes to mind this month as the birds start to sing melodiously and signs of colour start to appear in our gardens. The long dark months of winter are over, and we can imagine once again those hazy lazy days of summer.

As the light of the days lengthens, we enter the celebration of the Son, Easter. April is certainly the month of hope. Yet looking at our news headlines, hope feels in short supply. It is hard to remain hopeful for our planet, as world leaders vie for power, and our extreme weather systems indicate all is not well. Sitting in our crowded cathedral at the beginning of Lent speaking to Nazanin Zaghari-Ratcliffe and hearing her story of imprisonment as a hostage in Iran and injustice, I was reminded of a religious painting in the Methodist Art Collection. The painting is of the inside of the tomb on Easter morning. It shows the stone rolled away, not allowing us in, but allowing us to step out.

Nazanin recalled her experience of re-adjusting to the light of freedom. Stepping out into a life of hope means adjusting to a long-term view, believing that there is more goodness to come. It means enjoying the colour now and living in the hope of all eternity.

As Christians, Easter strengthens our belief that hope triumphs over despair, that light overcomes the darkness, and love wins. That is our song, which together we are called to sing. Despite everything, including the differences we live with every day, Jesus is Lord, the stone was rolled away so we can walk free and know eternal life.

hire charges. We will give plenty of warning of any increase and keep them as low as possible.

The essence of our news today is that through the generosity of our funders (SSE and the Parish Council) and the hard work of the trustees, it has been possible to continue the programme of improvements to the Reading Room and remove the need for those hiring it to feed the meters. A big thanks to Mark for managing the installation

The weaving grew, with Gillian and Emma on hand to help with questions that suddenly arose: ‘How do I change colour?’ and ‘How do I get it off the loom at the end?’

Not all of us got as far as ‘getting the weaving off at the end’ but we were very happy to head home with our looms and wool to finish our little project.

It was a most enjoyable evening spent in a warm and toasty Reading Room. Corsley WI were delighted to be the first people to benefit from the solar power which has been installed

at the Reading Room, we no longer need to feed the meter!

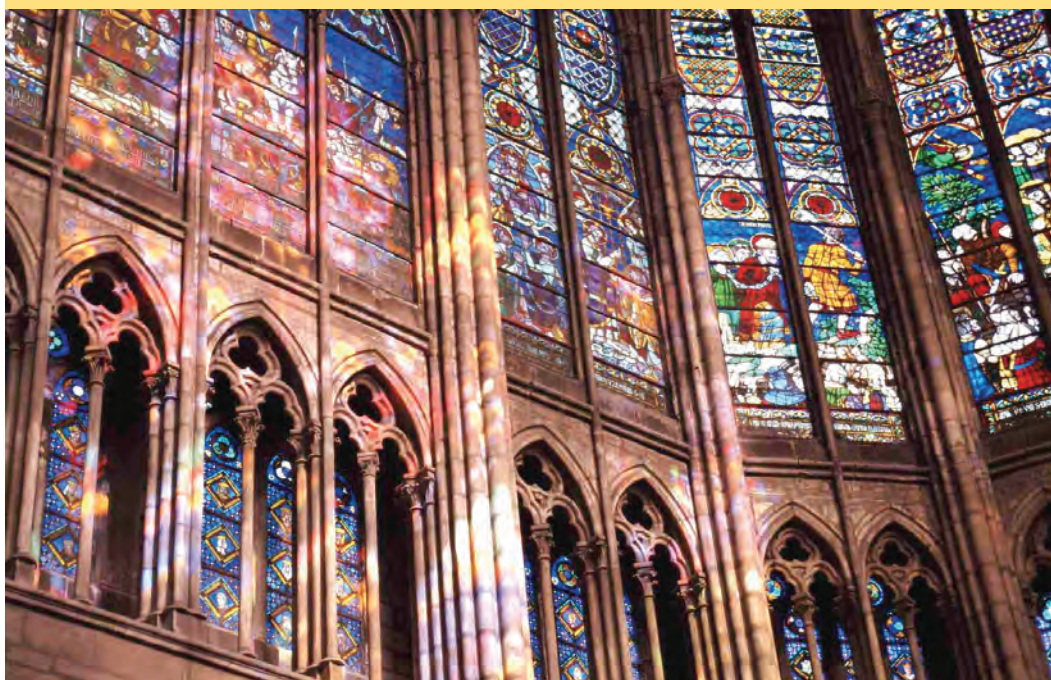

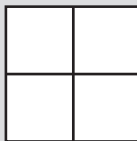

A view from over the hedge...

Countryside Matters

Spring has definitely sprung!

Spring certainly came early this year as March was exceptionally dry following February's rainfall of 79.6mm. This meant the milking cows were out grazing on 1st March, a joy to be seen as they skipped and jumped about enjoying the fresh air and freedom to run around after months of being confined to the barns. Now that the cows are out in the fields, the bedding they used can be removed and either piled up for use later in the year, or spread on the fields before being ploughed in for cereals or root crops. Unfortunately, some newcomers to the countryside are unaware how important it is that farmers use both the slurry and manure produced on the farm to assist the growth of the crops rather than using imported fertilisers, brought in at great expense, and increasing the carbon footprint.

This winter, a number of new hedges have been planted on the farm creating shelter belts for farm animals. The hedgerows will also provide safe corridors for wild mammals, nesting for birds, blossom for pollinators and berries for next winter. Sadly, the government grants that encourage farmers to do this has suddenly been withdrawn.

The hedgerows are now greening up beautifully – wild cherry trees are flowering and giving off a lovely perfume – they're not to be mistaken for the blackthorn which flowers later. Catkins and pussy willow are now heavy with pollen and lots of shrubs surrounding our gardens are laden with

flowers which the bumble bees are foraging.

Our native birds are pairing off and fighting for their own domain; the starlings are leaving their large groups to find new nesting grounds.

Listen out for the cuckoo this month and maybe you could let me know if there are any in our locality. Sadly, the national bird count shows very few cuckoos are now managing to get to our shores safely to breed, so let's hope that this traditional sound of spring can still be heard.

Do try to see the wonderful displays of bluebells in late April. Early morning when the dew is still on the ground is when the perfume is at its best, but do remember to keep to the tracks and footpaths which will allow others to enjoy the spectacle – trampling the flowers spoils it for others.

After the grey and miserable winter it's time to get out and enjoy our countryside this spring!

three days and three nights.’ Matt 12:40*

Did you Know?

Did you know that the Lord Jesus – the Son of God - became the Son of Man, so that the Sons of Men could become the Sons of God and inherit a place in Heaven?

Did you know that the Lord Jesus said, ‘You will hear of wars and rumours of wars, but see that you are not alarmed?’

Did you know that the Lord Jesus spoke about famines and earthquakes?

Did you know that the Lord Jesus spoke about His burial, in relation to Jonah and the Great Fish? ‘For as Jonah was in the belly of the huge fish three days and three nights, so the Son of Man will be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights.’

As we come towards the Easter period, theologians have deliberated over the celebration of Good Friday. For if the Lord Jesus was three days and three nights in the tomb and rose early on the first day of the week, then He must have been crucified before midday, when the sun was blotted out, on Thursday!

The sad thing is that people spend so much time seeking to prove the Bible that they miss what it is telling them about the Lord Jesus.

that archeologists would find the remains of Noah’s Ark on Mount Ararat, to prove that it was where the Ark came to rest. I tried to explain that knowing where the Ark landed would do nothing for him. The big question he needed to answer was, ‘What think ye of Christ?’

We hear a lot about wellbeing and, as we travel to the Chapel on a Sunday morning, we see all kinds of people looking after their physical wellbeing. There are the lycra-clad cyclists pedaling their bicycles as if their lives depended on it. There are people running as fast as they can, who glimpse occasionally at their watches to check if they are improving their performance. There are the walkers striding along the lanes taking their exercise.

Sad to say, the majority of people have no thought for their spiritual wellbeing, hence our church doors are passed by those looking after their physical wellbeing. As the hymn writer put it:

‘Room for pleasure, room for business,
